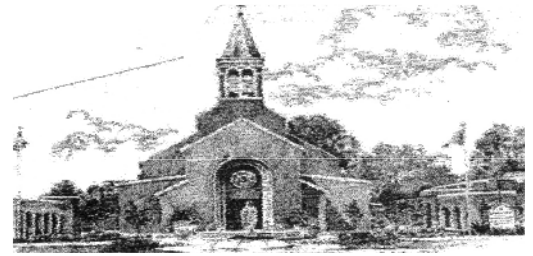

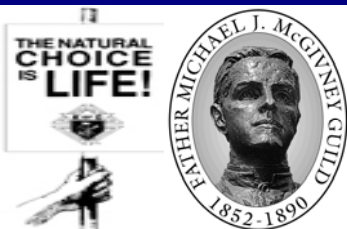
Grand Knights Day
