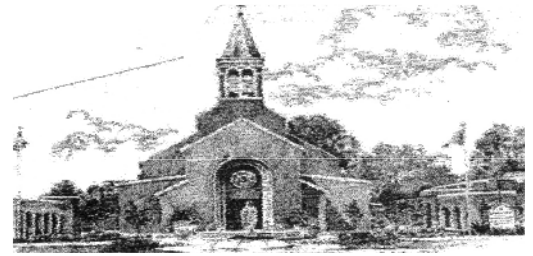

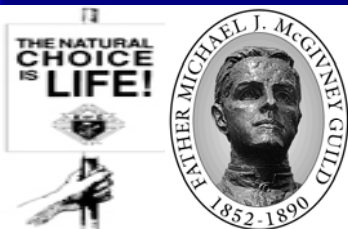
Squire Bowling Tournament
