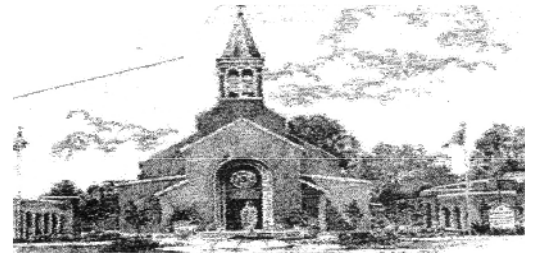

Fish Fry

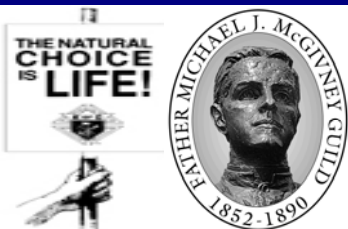
Our recent Fish Fry was not our biggest fund raiser of the year, but showed the strong support of our council. Thanks to all who was able to come out and help!
