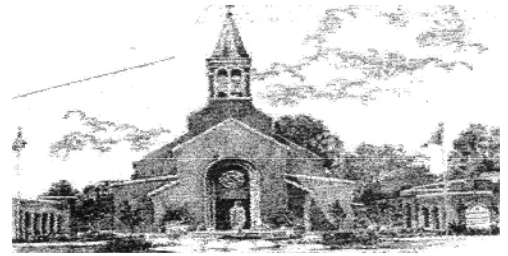

**Horseshoe Tournament August 18th**

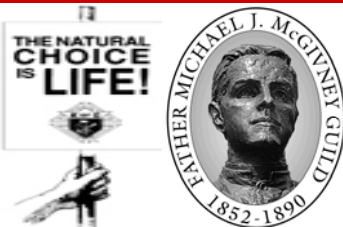
