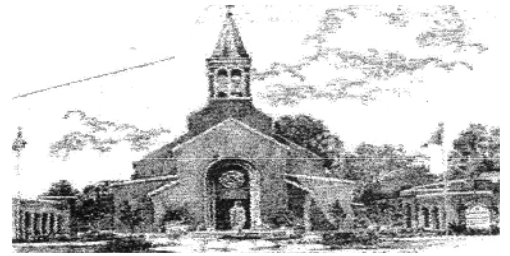

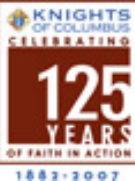
Squires State Softball Tournament
