State Horseshoe Tournament

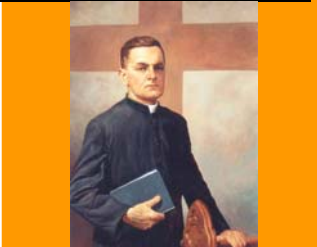
