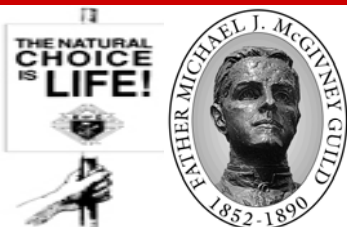
Council Achievements

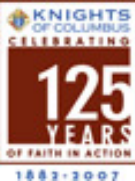
