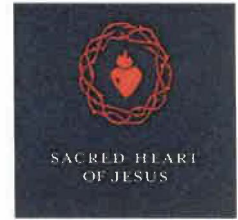

**APRIL 2025 SUPREME CHAPLAIN'S MONTHLY
CHALLENGE**

She said to him, "Yes, Lord. I have come to believe that you are the Messiah, the Son of God, the one who is coming into the world." (Gospel for April 6, Jn 11 :27)

These words belong to Martha, sister of Lazarus, as she and Jesus speak outside her brother's tomb. Her choice of words is important: "I have come to believe." This suggests her belief has evolved, that her previous uncertainty or ignorance about Jesus has blossomed into faith. Growing in faith is usually a process of moving from questioning or doubt to illumination and trust. How do we come to faith and then grow deeper in it? We do so through prayer, study and reflection. Let us continually deepen our faith in this manner.

Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori:

This month, I challenge you to take part in a Catholic faith formation course, event or opportunity offered through your local council (such as *Cor*), your parish or diocese, or online.

Questions for Reflection:

Looking at the development of your own faith, how have you "come to believe" truths about Christ and/or the Catholic faith? What teachings do you still have questions about? What areas of your faith would you like to develop further? Where can you find resources - or whom can you ask for resources - to help you deepen your faith and understanding?

Council News

Nominations for Officers for the new fraternal year will continue at the next business meeting. The following officers need to be elected:

Grand Knight: The Grand Knight is the highest ranking officer of his council, and is responsible for the welfare of the council. He presides over council meetings, acts as an ex-officio member of all committees, and ensures all necessary reports are submitted to the state and supreme council.

Deputy Grand Knight: The Deputy Grand Knight assists the Grand Knight with operation of the council and any other duties assigned to him by the Grand Knight. In the absence of the Grand Knight, he presides at council meetings.

Chancellor: The Chancellor is the third highest ranking officer of the council. He assists the Grand Knight and Deputy Grand Knight in the performance of their duties. He exercises a special interest in new members and members who are sick or in distress. He is charged with strengthening the members' interest in council activities.

Recorder: The Recorder is responsible for keeping and maintaining a true and permanent record of all actions of the council and maintains all correspondence of the council.

Treasurer: The Treasurer is charged with handling all council funds, deposits them in the proper accounts, and is responsible for paying all council expenses.

Advocate: The Advocate acts as parliamentarian for the council.

Warden: The Warden assures that all members at meetings possess the current membership card. He is the custodian of all council property except funds and is in charge of properly setting up the council chamber for meetings and ceremonial work.

Inside/Outside Guard: The Guards attend the doors of the council chamber, checking for current membership cards and allowing entrance.
