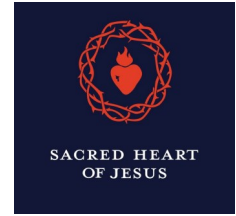

Second, I challenge you to help with the Food for Families or Coats for Kids Faith in Action program.

**Questions for Reflection:** Do you suffer well? How do you act and treat others when you are suffering? Have you ever met someone who had suffered greatly and been inspired by how they handled it?
